


A **hutong** is an ancient city alley or lane typical in Beijing It is a unique form of community that exists only in China.






The Great Wall, Beijing

The **Great Wall** of China was built over 2000 years ago, by Qin Shi Huangdi, the first emperor of China during the Qin (Ch'in) Dynasty







